We will close the school only when we consider it necessary. This will be because of staff shortage, the risk of children being stranded at school or for health and safety reasons, for instance no water or heating.

I will telephone the village representatives who will in turn contact their list (please see over). Please do not phone them, they will phone you.

If we close the school during the school day:

- We will ring parents, prioritising families living further away. Adults will remain in school until all children are collected. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date contact numbers.
- You may ring the school for information on 01308 482410 but may find the school number busy.
- Please collect your child from their class and ensure that an adult has ticked your child's name against the class register.
